



 - B. All dismissed and satisfied cases filed 1995 through 2000
2. Limited Actions - (Chapter 61)
 - A. All cases filed from 1977 through 1994
 - B. All cases filed 1998 and 1999
 - C. All dismissed and satisfied cases filed 1995 through 2000
3. Notice of Intent - filed from 1993 through 2003
4. Mechanic's Liens - filed from 1993 through 2003
5. Marriage license applications - from 1997 through 2003
6. Traffic tickets
 - A. All paid tickets from 1995 through 2001
7. Accounting Records
 - A. Daily balancing packets from 1997 through 1999
 - B. Closed fiduciary accounts from 1990 through 1996
 - C. Bail Bond Reports through 2002

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the records set forth above be destroyed by supervised shredding in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 108.
