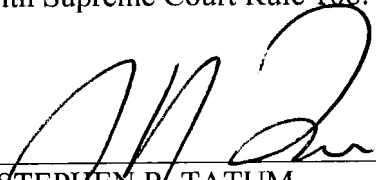
IN THE MATTER OF THE

PURSUANT TO SUPREME COURT RULE 108

NOW on this 21 day of June, 2006, the above matter comes on for hearing. The Court, after being well and fully advised, finds that:


1. The Kansas State Historical Society submitted a written response declining the transfer of any records contained in the attached Notice. The Johnson County Historical Society has requested certain civil and criminal records as set out in the memo attached.
2. The Clerk of the District Court also seeks authorization for destruction of bank statements/accounting records under Supreme Court Rule 108 which require no notice from 1995 through 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the records set forth above be destroyed by supervised shredding in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 108.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Administrative Orders No. 03-10, 04-02, 04-03 and 04-06, upon transferring of all original court files, pleadings and miscellaneous documents to digital images and indexing into the district court case management system, the Clerk of the District Court is authorized to destroy said original court files and documents and that said destruction shall be in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 108.

Hey Sandy!

After seeing the off-site storage today, and thinking about when we last visited your office, we've made some decisions regarding your records.

We have decided NOT to take any records after 1972. We just don't see the value in keeping the paper records when they are, or will eventually be scanned and filmed. I think they are just too current for our department. You can go ahead and dispose of whatever you need to after those years. I hope this hasn't caused you any inconvenience.

We WANT the CIVIL cases from 1939 to 1972 that are stored at Corporate Records. We chose to take through 1972 since you have those boxes currently sitting at the courthouse. We do not need CRIMINAL cases from 1970 to present.

We have also decided that we will take the records in the boxes you currently have them stored in. We can go ahead and move them to our acid free boxes at a later date when they are processed.

Although it may be years down the road, we are definitely interested in obtaining scanned copies of the records from 1939-1972 or having access to them. I think this would be very beneficial to the retrieval process.

Please let me know if you have questions. Again we hope this isn't causing any inconvenience but I think this is the most feasible solution to our storage situations.

We would still like to tour Corporate Records, so please let us know when you are free to do that.
