DISCOVERY ORDER REGARDING CONFIDENTIALITY IN  
CHILD IN NEED OF CARE PROCEEDINGS  
(Pursuant to K.S.A. 38-2201 *et seq*)

NOW on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2007, it is ordered that for good cause shown, and pursuant to an agreement between the State Department of SRS (hereinafter "SRS"), and its contractors and the Johnson County District Attorney's Office, that unless otherwise ordered by the court, discovery in all cases pursuant to K.S.A. 38-2201 *et seq*, shall be obtained by all interested parties in the following manner:

1. The contractor shall deliver to SRS all files and documents in their possession to SRS pertaining to the case at bar;

2. That SRS shall deliver all files and documents in their possession as well as those provided for in section 1, to the Johnson County District Attorney's Office pertaining to the case at bar, and;


3. That the Johnson County District Attorney's Office shall make all documents and files provided for in sections 1 and 2 available for review by all interested parties or as ordered by the court, and;

4. That all parties are admonished that the files provided for under this order may contain confidential material and as such each party is to comply with the confidentiality of said documents.


This agreement is limited to documents in the control of SRS and their contractors.
