
Re: Local Rule 26. Court Trustee lump sum fee adjustment.

As authorized by Johnson County Local Rule No. 26.4 the trustee's charge for the cost of enforcement is hereby modified and adjusted in the case of lump sum payments as follows:

26.4. In the case of lump sum payments of child support arrearages, the Court Trustee is entitled to recover the fee that has accrued on past due child support during the period of time the Trustee has been attempting to enforce the child support orders and shall not be limited to a one time \$10 monthly maximum fee. For each month a payment became due and owing and was not paid, the customary monthly fee will be calculated. Each parties' share of the monthly fee will be deducted before disbursement by the Kansas Payment Center of the lump sum payment to the obligee. Within twenty days from the date the Trustee takes the fee the Trustee shall send written notice to the parties clearly advising them **in bold stand-out font** of the amount of the fee and that they are entitled to a Hearing Officer review of the fee taken from the lump sum. A request for review of any lump sum Court Trustee fee must be made within thirty days of the notice. Rule 26.12 shall apply in regard to the Finality of Orders, Review Hearings, and Motions for Rehearing.
