ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


The Judges of the District Court of Johnson County, Kansas, have created a Domestic Violence Docket. In order to identify domestic violence cases, the District Attorney will designate appropriate cases with a "DV" in the upper right corner of the complaint. The Clerk of the District Court is directed to assign all cases with a "DV" designation to the division of the District Court assigned the responsibility of domestic violence cases.

Upon determining a case has been inappropriately designated "DV", the assigned court shall direct the Clerk to randomly reassign the case. Authority to assign or reassign pursuant to this Order is specifically delegated to the Domestic Violence Court and the Clerk of the District Court.

The Judges of the District Court of Johnson County, Kansas, have created a Misdemeanor Docket. The Clerk of the District Court is directed to assign all misdemeanor cases, exclusive of cases designated "DV" and traffic misdemeanors, to the court assigned the responsibility of handling the non-"DV" and non-traffic misdemeanors. In order to allocate the Misdemeanor Docket among the Criminal Department Judges, the court assigned to handle non-"DV" and non-traffic is specifically authorized to reassign the number of cases appropriate to equalize the Misdemeanor Docket. Reassignment of cases is necessary to equalize the case load among the Criminal Department Judges.

This Order supersedes Court Rules to the extent it is inconsistent with existing Court Rules. This Order shall be effective retroactive to January 1, 1996.
