Now on this 1 day of October, 1996, this matter comes on before the Honorable Larry McClain, Administrative Judge of the Tenth Judicial District, for an order to the Clerk of the District Court to destroy certain court records pursuant to Kansas Supreme Court Rule 108. Attached hereto and made a part of this Order by reference is a computer-generated report of small claims and civil cases that have been dismissed for lack of prosecution through 1995, in accordance with Rule No. 6 of the Rules of Court for the Tenth Judicial District of Kansas, December 17, 1992.

The Court has been informed by the Clerk of the District Court, Ramona Allenbrand, that all cases reflected in this report have been indexed and were microfilmed in accordance with applicable procedures. Notice has been given pursuant to Rule 108. Neither the Kansas Historical Society or the Johnson County Archives has an interest in receiving these court records.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE COURT ORDERED that the Clerk of the District Court destroy all court files listed on the attached report by shredding and make due return of this writ.
