ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ~~8~~ 5

The Judges of the District Court of Johnson County, Kansas, have created a Misdemeanor VCL Docket. After arraignment in the regularly-assigned court, all misdemeanor VCL cases will be assigned to be heard by Court 88, the court assigned the responsibility of the Misdemeanor VCL Docket.

If it is determined that a case has been inappropriately designated a misdemeanor VCL, the assigned court shall direct the clerk to randomly reassign the case. Authority to assign or reassign pursuant to this Order is specifically delegated to Court 88 and the Clerk of the District Court.


If a misdemeanor VCL count is included in a case with other criminal counts, the case will be assigned to the regularly-assigned Criminal Department Judges according to established docketing procedures for criminal cases.

This Order shall be effective retroactive to November 1, 1996.
