ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #2 - 1998

Pursuant to K.S.A. 22-3214, all law enforcement officers within Johnson County, Kansas, are authorized to serve subpoenas to compel the attendance of victims of domestic violence.

Subpoenas authorized by this order authorize the subpoena anytime after the arrest of any person accused of a crime of domestic violence and said subpoena shall require the attendance of the witnesses at the first appearance call of the docket in the Domestic Violence Court in Johnson County.


