
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING
APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL IN FELONY CASES

Administrative Order No.: _____/_____

In all cases in which counsel is appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 22-4503, at any stage of the proceedings on a felony charge, the defendant is ordered to pay an administrative fee of \$35.00 to the Office of the Clerk of the District Court. The Clerk shall pay all \$35.00 administrative fees collected, at least monthly, to the State Treasurer for deposit into the state treasury to the credit of the Indigents Defense Services Fund. This administrative fee shall be paid after court costs and probation fees, but before restitution, if any, and before attorney fees and aid to indigent defense fees ordered under K.S.A. 22-4513. This administrative fee shall be assessed at time of conviction.
