


IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #8-1998 (REVISED JANUARY 20, 2000)

Juvenile Diversion Fees

The Courts of Johnson County, Tenth Judicial District of the State of Kansas, have established a Juvenile Diversion Program. This Program is funded with the payment of diversion fees.

Effective January 20, 2000, the fee for diversion, in addition to all other costs and filing fees, is \$35 per month. All misdemeanor diversions will be a minimum of at least four months and all felony diversions at least nine months in duration. In addition to this charge, any case requiring an extension of the diversion period shall be assessed a fee of \$35 per month until the requirements of the diversion are complete.

All diversion fees shall be paid to the Clerk of the District Court. The Clerk of the District Court shall disburse all funds ready for disbursement on or about the first day of each month and said funds shall be paid to the Court Services Office.
