ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 00 - 5

Re: Terri Stroh Tweedly, Esq.

Based upon information received from the Office of the Disciplinary Administrator, including the affidavit of J. Nick Badgerow, the clients of attorney Terri Stroh Tweedly are being neglected.

Therefore, pursuant to Kansas Supreme Court Rule 221, Joseph R. Horgan of Olathe, Kansas, an attorney engaged in the private practice of law in this judicial district, is hereby appointed to forthwith seize and inventory the client files in the law office of Terri Stroh Tweedly at 8700 Monrovia, Suite 310, Lenexa, Johnson County, Kansas; to report to the court on the status of the files seized; and, subject to the approval of the chief judge, to take such further action as may be necessary to protect the interest of Ms. Tweedly and her clients.

Mr. Horgan is authorized to enter the office of Ms. Tweedly; to review all files present at the office; to open all mail addressed to Ms. Tweedly which appears to relate to cases or matters of clients; and to respond to any clients of Ms. Tweedly who have inquired about the status of their cases.

If instructed to do so by a client of Ms. Tweedly, Mr. Horgan shall return to such client the client's file and related documents, provided that the file and

documents are first copied and the copies retained by Mr. Horgan.


Mr. Horgan shall not disclose any information contained in any of the files, records, or correspondence maintained by Ms. Tweedly except as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Administrative Order.

Mr. Horgan shall maintain accurate records of his time and expenses incurred in this matter and submit a statement to the court upon completion of the matters covered by this Administrative Order.

The Sheriff of Johnson County, Kansas, is ordered and directed to accompany Mr. Horgan and take such action (including the use of reasonable force, if necessary) to enable Mr. Horgan to enter the premises at 8700 Monrovia, Suite 310, Lenexa, Johnson County, Kansas, and to seize the files of Ms. Tweedly described in this Administrative Order.


