ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 02-5

Re: Implementation of Risk/Needs Assessment Tool

House substitute for Senate Bill 9 (Chapter 177, 2002 Session Laws of Kansas) enacted by the legislature in 2002, amends K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 75-5291 to include the following:

(3) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary and subject to the availability of funding therefor, adult offenders sentenced to community supervision in Johnson county for felony crimes that occurred on or after July 1, 2002, but before July 1, 2004, shall be placed under court services or community corrections supervision based upon court rules issued by the chief judge of the 10th judicial district. The provision contained in this subsection shall not apply to offenders transferred by the assigned agency to an agency located outside Johnson county. The provisions of this section shall expire on July 1, 2004.”

In furtherance of this legislation, Court Services for the 10th Judicial District, under the supervision of the Chief Court Services Officer and the Chief Judge of the Criminal Department of the District Court, shall undertake a pilot project to implement and test a new Risk/Needs assessment tool and to assign felony criminal


