Based upon information received from the Office of the Disciplinary Administrator, the clients of attorney Michael B. Dunalewicz are being neglected. Therefore, pursuant to Kansas Supreme Court Rule 221, Samuel P. Logan of Foulston, Siefkin LLP in Overland Park, Kansas, an attorney engaged in the private practice of law in this judicial district, is hereby appointed to forthwith contact Mr. Dunalewicz and to request that he voluntarily permit Mr. Logan to inventory and review all of Mr. Dunalewicz's client files in accordance with this administrative order; or, in the absence of Mr. Dunalewicz's cooperation, to obtain and inventory any client files of Mr. Dunalewicz in the possession of the office of Disciplinary Administrator, 701 SW Jackson, 1st Floor, Topeka Ks 66603; to report to the court on the status of the files obtained; and, subject to the approval of the chief judge, to take such further action as may be necessary to protect the interest of Mr. Dunalewicz and his clients.

Mr. Logan is authorized to review all files of Mr. Dunalewicz; to open all mail addressed to Mr. Dunalewicz which appears to relate to cases or matters of clients; and to respond to any clients of Mr. Dunalewicz who have inquired about the status of their cases.

If instructed to do so by a client of Mr. Dunalewicz, Mr. Logan shall return to such client the client's file and related documents, provided that the file and


documents are first copied and the copies retained by Mr. Logan.

Mr. Logan shall not disclose any information contained in any of the files, records, or correspondence maintained by Mr. Dunalewicz except as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Administrative Order.

Mr. Logan shall maintain accurate records of his time and expenses incurred in this matter and submit a statement to the court upon completion of the matters covered by this Administrative Order.



Dear Mr. Dunalewicz:

As you know, Samuel P. Logan has been appointed by the court to collect your client files for the purpose of contacting the clients relating to those files and, if requested, return them to the clients for further handling. I understand from the Disciplinary Administrator that you are in the process of surrendering your law license. Mr. Logan is currently drafting letters to your clients to advise them that he now has their files. The burden of making copies of all the files before their return may be substantial. 
