


IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF JOHNSON COUNTY, KANSAS
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 03-9

RE: CAMERAS AND VIDEO RECORDING IN THE COURTHOUSE

No cameras or video recording devices shall be permitted in the courthouse without the prior approval of the Chief Judge of the District Court or the Chief Judge's designee. News media may obtain approval from the judge before whom a particular proceeding is being held. Approval is not required for cameras and video recording devices used to memorialize the final hearing in adoption proceedings and wedding ceremonies conducted in the courthouse, subject to any limitations imposed by the judge before whom such proceedings or ceremonies are held.
