Administrative Order No. 08-02

Pursuant to K.S.A. 21-2511, DNA samples must be collected from those juveniles placed in custody for, charged with, or adjudicated for certain offenses. If the juvenile was not processed through the Juvenile Intake and Assessment Center (JIAC), the necessary sample may not have been collected prior to adjudication. Upon adjudication, the DNA samples must be collected and submitted to the Kansas Bureau of Investigation in all cases as required by statute.

If the necessary sample has not been collected, the juvenile's supervising officer is ordered to direct the juvenile offender to the Juvenile Intake and Assessment Center for collection and submission of the DNA samples to the Kansas Bureau of Investigation. Further, the Juvenile Intake and Assessment Center is ordered to collect and submit DNA samples from those juveniles placed in custody for, charged with, or adjudicated for certain offenses as required by K.S.A. 21-2511.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
