Re: Jurisdiction of Magistrate Judges to Conduct Felony Arraignments

K.S.A. 20-302b(a) and K.S.A. 22-2902(7) grant a district magistrate judge jurisdiction to conduct a felony arraignment if the chief judge of the judicial district assigned the district magistrate judge to conduct felony arraignments. Under K.S.A. 20-329, the chief judge of the district court has the authority to assign cases within the district.

In the Tenth Judicial District, all district magistrate judges are assigned and authorized to conduct arraignments in felony cases.
