
**Administrative Order No. 09-06**

In order to expedite the service of process for civil matters upon a party who is located at any Adult Detention Center or Sheriff's Office-owned or -operated facility in Johnson County, Kansas, the Court directs as follows:

For service of process pursuant to Chapter 60 and Chapter 61, the Johnson County Sheriff's Office may, in its discretion, make service upon the above-referenced subject, pursuant to Kansas Statutes regarding service, specifically K.S.A. 60-303(d) or K.S.A. 61-3003(d), by sending the service documents by facsimile to the appropriate facility. A designated deputy will serve the subject, and will then send the executed return of service information back to the Sheriff's Office Civil Division, both by facsimile and by delivery of the document with the original signature of the deputy who makes service. The Sheriff's Office Civil Division may proceed to enter the return information into the Court's records upon receipt of the facsimile. When the document with the original signature is returned to the Sheriff's Office Civil Division, it will be forwarded to the Clerk of the District Court to be maintained in the Court's case file record.
