**DISTRICT COURT TRUSTEE OFFICE PAY & COMPENSATION, BENEFITS,
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES**

NOW on this 30th day of October, 2009 comes on before the Chief Judge of Johnson County, Kansas the matter of pay and compensation, benefits, and administrative procedures for the Office of the District Court Trustee.


After due consideration of the matter and the applicable statutes and court rules, the following administrative order is adopted:

The Chief Judge of the District Court directs that the Court Trustee in all matters governed by statute, including, but not limited to, *K.S.A.* 20-162(b), 20-349, 20-358 and 20-359, shall utilize the Johnson County, Kansas Human Resource Policies and Procedures in all matters not governed by, or in conflict with, the Kansas Supreme Court Rules relating to Kansas Court Personnel including, but not limited to:

1. The pay and compensation scale, including annual leave accumulation;
2. Recruitment services, hiring and placement;
3. Medical coverage, retirement, FMLA and other workplace benefits.

This memorializes the practices of the Office of the District Court Trustee as authorized and followed for prior years, and shall continue for 2009 and all subsequent years, unless modified by written agreement of the Chief Judge and the Court Trustee.
