ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


In re James Kiley - Rule 221

2013-10

On August 6, 2013, the Court appointed John Taylor and Ernest C. Ballweg to protect and assist the clients of James Kiley, a deceased attorney who was practicing in Johnson County, Kansas, at the time of his death. The appointment was made pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 221. Pursuant to this Supreme Court Rule, John Taylor and Ernest C. Ballweg, were granted approval to "take such action as may be necessary to protect the interests" of James Kiley's clients.

This grant of authority includes accessing James Kiley's IOLTA account, located at the Bank of the West in the account named and numbered as Business Int. Checking IOLTA #024-649749, to determine what clients have funds in the said account and returning those funds to the respective clients. John Taylor and Ernest C. Ballweg shall have the legal authority to sign, with their name, the reimbursement checks to the clients. After disposing of all the funds within the IOLTA account, John Taylor and Ernest C. Ballweg, shall provide an accounting of the distributions to the Court and thereupon close the IOLTA account. John Taylor and Ernest Ballweg shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred related to this Order as determined are necessary and reasonable by the Chief Judge.
