RE: PROTECTION FROM ABUSE & PROTECTION FROM STALKING
EMAIL NOTICE TO POLICE DEPARTMENTS

PURPOSE

To set forth the practice and procedure for notifying Johnson County cities and police jurisdictions of court process on Protection of Abuse Orders, Stalking Orders to include all Emergency, Temporary and Final PFA's, Orders of Continuance, Dismissals, Amended Orders and all other related matters addressed for service upon local police jurisdictions by **electronic mail**.

ORDER

Copies of Protection From Abuse pleadings and Orders and Protection From Stalking pleadings and Orders required to be issued to police departments of the city where the Plaintiff resides pursuant to KSA 60-3101, et. seq., KSA 60-31a01, et. seq. and KSA 60-31b01 et. seq. shall be delivered to police departments located within Johnson County, Kansas by electronic means, except for those papers required to be served by some other means. Service by e-mail is deemed complete when transmitted to the email address identified by the Chief of Police of such city to the Johnson County Sheriff, unless the e-mail is returned immediately as undeliverable by the recipient's e-mail system. The Sheriff shall include and file a certificate of service specifying the time and manner of notice used.
