ORDER OF APPOINTMENT PURSUANT TO KANSAS SUPREME COURT RULE 221

Now on this 1st day of July, 2014, comes on before the Chief Judge of the 10th Judicial District of Kansas (or his designee), and hereby considers the appointment of counsel to protect clients' interests for the law practice of Gary L. Sloan, deceased.

Whereupon, the Court considers the need for appointment of a licensed attorney to manage and assume responsibility for the continuation and winding up of the law practice of Gary L. Sloan, who is now deceased.

John P. Gerstle, Attorney at Law, is hereby designated by the Court pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 221 to handle the administration and management of all client matters and law office matters for Gary L. Sloan.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COURT, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that John P. Gerstle is hereby appointed as counsel of record to handle the administration and management of all client matters and law office matters for Gary L. Sloan, pursuant to Kansas Supreme Court Rule 221.

IT IS, FURTHER, BY THE COURT, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that John P. Gerstle is hereby appointed as counsel of record and is hereby granted the following authority by the Court to undertake any and all acts necessary for the proper representation of the clients of Gary L. Sloan, to inventory all client files and to take all necessary actions to protect the interests of such clients as may be necessary, including, but not

limited to, authorization to enter a conditional appearance in any pending matters on behalf of the clients (which conditional entry of appearance shall be subject to the appropriate notice to said clients, the Court and opposing counsel and approval of such client for continued representation); to further authorize the transfer of any such legal representation of clients to other duly licensed attorneys for the purpose of handling such client matters as may be necessary; to take any such action as may be necessary to protect the interests of Gary L. Sloan's law practice and the clients of Gary L. Sloan; to negotiate checks and any other negotiable instruments which may be payable to said Gary L. Sloan as attorney representing his clients; to withdraw and/or disburse any funds in the operating account of the law practice maintained by and in the name of Gary L. Sloan; to withdraw and/or disburse any client funds in the IOLTA trust account maintained in the name of Gary L. Sloan; to take any and all necessary actions for the proper management and administration of the law practice of Gary L. Sloan in order to timely conclude all legal and administrative work related to the representation of clients and the financial matters of such law practice, and any other actions which may be necessary for the management and control of the law practice of Gary L. Sloan.


IT IS, FURTHER, BY THE COURT, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said attorney appointed herein shall be granted the authority to act on behalf of Gary L. Sloan in all transactions, necessary endorsements and authorizing signators, handling of negotiable instruments, withdrawals, deposits and any other matters related to the business operating account in the name of Gary L. Sloan that may be maintained at any bank and the IOLTA trust account in the name of Gary L. Sloan maintained at any bank.

IT IS, FURTHER, BY THE COURT, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said attorney appointed herein shall be authorized to take all necessary

actions on behalf of Gary L. Sloan to protect the interests of all clients of Gary L. Sloan pursuant to Kansas Supreme Court Rule 221.

IT IS, FURTHER, BY THE COURT, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that John P. Gerstle shall file an accounting with the Court at the close of all matters pertaining to all financial transactions undertaken by said attorney in the course of this appointment pursuant to Rule 221, and shall be entitled to compensation for his reasonable attorney fees and expenses associated with fulfillment of his duties under this Order.
