ORDER APPOINTING JUDGES PRO TEM

NOW, on this 30th day of July, 2014, due to the demands of the docket in the 10th Judicial District and for good cause shown, the undersigned Chief Judge of the 10th Judicial District of the State of Kansas, hereby appoints our law trained Magistrate Judges, Judge Michael Farley, Judge Linda Trigg, Judge James Phelan, Judge Daniel Vokins, as District Judges Pro Tem to serve as such from this day forward until this appointment is rescinded, as set forth below.

This appointment shall be for the purpose of presiding over and conducting hearings and trials, making rulings and findings, and issuing temporary and final orders in the following cases filed or pending in the 10th Judicial District and shall have full power and authority as District Judges Pro Tem as ordered herein in said cases:


1. child in need of care actions;
2. juvenile offender actions;
3. child support modification and enforcement actions;
4. protection from abuse and protection from stalking actions; and,
5. probate proceedings.

The undersigned Chief Judge finds the Magistrate Judges in the 10th Judicial District are each regularly admitted to the practice of law in the State of Kansas, have maintained active status membership in the bar of the State of Kansas and are District Magistrate Judges in good standing with the Supreme Court of the State of Kansas and are fit and proper persons to be appointed District Judges Pro Tem to carry out the duties of this appointment.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE COURT ORDERED that Judge Michael Farley, Judge Linda Trigg, Judge James Phelan, and Judge Daniel Vokins, are hereby appointed District Judges Pro Tem to serve as such from this day forward until this appointment is rescinded, for the purposes set forth above, shall have full power and authority as District Judge Pro Tem as ordered herein.

No compensation, over and above the salary and benefits currently paid to the appointees herein in their positions as District Magistrate Judges, shall be paid to the District Judges Pro Tem appointed herein.
