**Administrative Order No. 15-01**


Johnson County Department of Corrections (JCDOC) currently has a House Arrest Program. In furtherance of this program, it is ordered:

In the event any person serving an hourly sentence in the House Arrest Program for post-imprisonment supervision under K.S.A. 8-1567(b)(3) shall commit or be charged with the commission of any criminal offense or shall commit a material violation of the rules and regulation of the program, JCDOC is authorized to suspend such person from the benefits of the program and the Sheriff of Johnson County is authorized to detain such person as a general prisoner until an order of custodial transfer may be entered by the Court on the next business day.

On the business day following transfer of a detained person, JCDOC staff will provide the Court a proposed written Order of Custodial Transfer for consideration and signature. Upon obtaining the signed Order of the Court, JCDOC staff will provide the original order to the Johnson County Clerk of the District Court. Once the Order of Custodial Transfer is file stamped by the Johnson County Court Clerk of the District Court, JCDOC staff shall provide a copy to the Johnson County Sheriff.
