Juvenile Supervision Fees


Kansas Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 251 allows each Judicial District to establish a juvenile offender supervision fee schedule. The Tenth Judicial District previously established a juvenile offender supervision fee schedule on July 29, 2011, by Administrative Order 11-2. This Order has not been modified as of this date.

Henceforth, any juvenile offender adjudicated for an offense which, if committed by an adult would constitute a misdemeanor, shall pay a supervision fee of \$50.00. Additionally, any juvenile offender adjudicated for an offense which, if committed by an adult would constitute a felony, shall pay a supervision fee of \$100.00.

The Court may waive all or part of the supervision fee upon a showing that such a fee would result in an undue hardship to the juvenile offender or the juvenile's parent or guardian.

This Order shall be effective for all juvenile offenders placed on supervision as of January 9, 2015.
