

FIREARMS IN THE COURTHOUSE

In the interest of maintaining a fair, safe, secure, unintimidating and civil forum for all, no persons other than Johnson County Sheriff's Deputies, Johnson County Sheriff's Special Deputies assigned to the District Attorney's office, and the permanently assigned Kansas Highway Patrol Liaison Trooper shall possess a firearm within the Johnson County Courthouse.

Firearms which are disabled, made incapable of firing, and intended for use as evidence, may be possessed or carried in the courthouse and be brought into a courtroom with the prior consent of the assigned Judge in that division. Such firearms shall be at all times subject to control by the Sheriff's Court Security Detail, and be kept in a locked storage compartment when not in use as evidence. Such firearms shall not be provided to a jury except upon consent of the assigned Judge after consultation with the Sheriff's Court Security Detail.
