

Both attorneys have all the rights and responsibilities necessary to do the following:

1. Inventory all legal files and determine the status of each file.
2. Inform all clients of their legal options.
3. Obtain a financial accounting of each legal file.
4. Negotiate any checks which may be payable to Mr. Dickerson for legal services.
5. Withdraw, deposit, and disburse any funds necessary to properly maintain the IOLTA trust account until the same is closed.
6. Withdraw, deposit, and disburse any funds necessary from the business operating account(s) as required to timely conclude all legal and administrative work of Mr. Dickerson's legal practice until the same is closed.
7. Receive and review mail related to Mr. Dickerson's legal practice.
8. Notify all creditors of Mr. Dickerson's death.
9. Update the Chief District Court Judge every 90 days from date of appointment on the progress toward closing Mr. Dickerson's law practice.
10. Upon completion of these responsibilities, inform the Chief Judge in writing that all responsibilities and tasks have been completed.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that N. Russell Hazlewood and Gary D. White, Jr. are hereby appointed, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 221, to take all necessary action to close the law practice of Stephen G. Dickerson, as required by the Rule.
