ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2017- 08


Michael Lawless

Now on this 11th day of August, 2017, this Court has confirmed that Michael Lawless is no long incapacitated as previously stated on July 3, 2017. The Court issued Administrative Order 2017-07, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 221, authorizing Mark Kolich and Mike Hodges to protect the interests of Mr. Lawless' clients while he was incapable of practicing law.

The Court has confirmed with Mr. Lawless' treating physician that he is able to return to the practice of law. Dr. Ambilitchu made this determination based upon his findings and observations, along with consulting Dr. Noll. The presenting issue was isolated and manageable with medication.

The previous Order authorizing Mr. Kolich and Mr. Hodges to protect the interests of Mr. Lawless' clients is hereby set aside and Mr. Lawless is removed from an restrictions imposed under Supreme Court Rule 221.
