ORDER OF APPOINTMENT PURSUANT TO KANSAS SUPREME COURT RULE 221

Now on this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2018, the Chief Judge of the 10<sup>th</sup> Judicial District of Kansas was informed that Mark R. Logan, an attorney whose primary office is located in Johnson County, Kansas, is no longer able to practice law for one of the reasons set forth in Supreme Court Rule 221.

**APPOINTED COUNSEL**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 221 this Court appoints **Jason McClasky**, as **Appointed Counsel**.

**Appointed Counsel** confirms he/she is a licensed practicing attorney in the State of Kansas to inventory the legal files of the legal practice and take such action as may be necessary to protect the interests of the legal practice and the clients of the legal practice.

**Appointed Counsel** shall not disclose any information contained in any file inventoried except as necessary to carry out the Order of this Court.

This appointment pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 221 grants the Appointee all rights and responsibilities necessary to protect the interests of the legal practice and the clients of the legal practice. This includes but is not limited to the following:

1. Inventorying all legal files and determine the status of each file.
2. Inform all clients of their legal options.
3. Obtain a financial accounting of each legal file.
4. Negotiate any checks which may be payable to the legal practice for legal services.
5. Withdraw, deposit, and disburse any funds necessary to properly maintain the IOLTA trust account until the same is closed.
6. Withdraw, deposit, and disburse any funds necessary from the business operating account(s) as required to timely conclude all legal and administrative work of the legal practice until the same is closed.
7. Update Chief District Court Judge every 90 days from date of appointment on progress.
8. Receive mail related to his/her legal practice.
9. Receive all passwords related to his/her legal practice.

Upon acceptance of this appointment the Chief Judge will notify the Disciplinary Administrator of this appointment.

This appointment shall be for a period of no longer than nine months and the Appointee must provide the Chief District Court Judge a final accounting at the end of the three months, unless an extension of the period of appointment is requested and granted.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Jason McClasky is hereby appointed pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 221 for Mark R. Logan.
