NOW on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2018, in conjunction with the Order of the Kansas Supreme Court (2018 SC 104) issued on December 3, 2018, which provides for a day of leave for court personnel in the State of Kansas, the Tenth Judicial District shall be authorized to conduct any court proceedings scheduled for December 5, as determined by the Judge assigned to handle the division's docket.

The Court will allow as many court staff personnel as possible to participate in the national and state observance of the National Day of Mourning in honor of President George H.W. Bush. In the interests of justice and to properly accommodate the parties and counsel, the Johnson County District Court will otherwise remain open on December 5 with a minimal crew for those courts which cannot reschedule or cancel its hearings or trials.
