
COMPENSATION OF PART-TIME HEARING OFFICERS

NOW on this 23 day of August, 1999, comes on for the Administrative Judge of Johnson County, Kansas the matter of increased compensation for the Hearing Officers of the Tenth Judicial District of Kansas.

K.S.A. 23-497 (1988) provides that the compensation to be paid in the Office of the District Court Trustee shall be as determined by the Administrative Judge.

After due consideration of the matter and the applicable statutes and court rules, the following administrative order is promulgated:

Section I. That effective July 1, 1999 a 2 % increase in compensation shall be granted the following Hearing Officers of the Tenth Judicial District of Kansas payable through the Office of the District Court Trustee: William Coffee, Charles Elliott and Melanie Busse.
