
MORATORIUM ON RESIDENTIAL EVICTIONS

This Order is being issued in response to the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Johnson County, Kansas. In the effort to maintain as much recommended social distancing as practicable and allow persons to shelter in place and be able to self-quarantine or self-isolate themselves and their families at home if needed, the Court is acting for the greater public good during this extraordinary period.

In order to reduce Court-enforced homelessness during this pandemic period, the Court orders a moratorium on the execution of evictions, by Writ of Restitution or Writ of Assistance or any other name issued from this District Court, for a period of not less than thirty (30) days from the date of issuance of any such writs or orders to vacate such residential premises.

This Order may be extended as circumstances may change.
